

Emergency surcharge - Surcharge on Express & Economy shipments

Emergency Surcharge (ES) is a temporary surcharge to cover operational cost increases for emergencies beyond Seabourne Logistics' control. This includes (but is not limited to) changes in market dynamics and Air capacity availability.

Seabourne will continue to evaluate and adjust this surcharge as market conditions evolve for the duration of the situation.

In response to the situation in the past year, we are forced to make some temporary changes, in light of the increased demand for Air freight capacity and increased costs, in order to maintain our service during this period. To ensure operational continuity, Seabourne Logistics will temporarily impose an 'Emergency Surcharge' on all Express and Economy shipments until further notice.
